

Retiree Permit

Definition and Purpose

This defines how faculty and staff who retire can purchase a permit at a discounted rate.

Rules and Regulations

- Retiree permits are valid from the date of purchase through August 14.
- GT retirees who are fully retired can purchase a Retiree Permit.
- GT retirees who are working part-time must park in un-gated, non-residential parking zones or may request gate access for one gated lot.
- GT retirees working part-time will be charged one-half the cost of an Annual Permit.

Restrictions

- New retirees are required to show documentation and authorization must be granted by their supervisor.
- Payroll-deduction is not an option for either pricing level of GT RetireePermits.
- Retiree Permit must be paid for at the point-of-sale.
- If a permit is lost or stolen, a replacement fee will be charged.
